Areas of specialism and special facilities	<ul> <li>We have 5 permanent LSAs, with training and experience in Makaton, PECS and Intensive Interaction.</li> <li>One Class Teacher is also a qualified Speech and Language Therapist.</li> <li>Nursery Education Officers and teaching staff have attended Hackney Learning Trust training courses in Makaton and SCERTS.</li> <li>We have a regular Speech and Language Therapist working within the school two days a week throughout the school year.</li> <li>We have a Sensory Room (The Pod) with a wide range of sensory equipment and resources.</li> <li>We have a separate, resourced, quiet room (Rainbow Room) for language groups, physiotherapy etc. if required. This can also be used a calm space for children who would benefit from this.</li> <li>We have close links to Hackney Ark, with regular visits and support from the Health Service Professionals based there.</li> <li>We are based in a single level, accessible building, with disabled toilets and changing facilities.</li> </ul>
