## **Natural Explorers at Comet**

As you may be aware children (3 and 4 year olds) whose families are on a low income are entitled to Early Years Pupil Premium funding that is paid to the nursery. With this money we provide a range of activities and experiences that will enhance their learning



and broaden their vocabulary. We are doing this by providing gardening activities, small outings, forest school activities, natural materials and interests in scientific enquiry. Many of the activities are for all children and we call these universal activities. Our recent activities have been to observe an octopus that we got from the fishmongers, trips to a Vietnamese restaurant, the garden centre, the aquarium, buying fish to look after at nursery and Shoreditch Park.
