# Early Years Pupil Premium and Free School Meals

#### Apply for free school meals | Hackney Education

If you are entitled to free school meals the school automatically gets Early Years Pupil Premium Funding of £388 per year. This means that your child will become part of our Natural Explorers group and will be able to go on local trips, be involved in Forest School and gardening activities. We really do rely on this extra funding to make sure our children get lots of different opportunities to extend their learning and interests.

All children eligible for free schools meals will receive a FREE t-shirt as a thank you for registering.

#### **Home Learning – Book Borrowing**

We have lots of information and ideas for home learning so please see your child's keyworker if you would like information on something in particular. In addition, the 'Home Learning' section of the website is also full of ideas and stories to explore with your child.



We also provide a book borrowing service. Children will be provided with a school book bag and will be able to choose a book to bring home every Wednesday. Please share this book with your child and also keep it safe and cared for.

Please return the book bag the following Tuesday ready for a new book.

There is a charge of £5 for a book and £5 for a bookbag if you lose them or do not return them at the end of your time with us.
