A DEPOSIT OF £20 IS REQUIRED TO BOOK. THE FULL DEPOSIT IS REFUNDABLE ON COMPLETION OF THE COURSE. TO COMPLETE THE COURSE, YOU MUST ATTEND ON BOTH DAYS AND COMPLETE THE ENROLMENT FORM AND ANY OTHER REQUESTED GLA FUNDING RELATED FORMS.
