
ParentPay

We are introducing a more convenient way to pay for school dinners, trips, breakfast and tea club, top-up hours and school uniform online, using a secure service called ParentPay. ParentPay will be live at school this week and we will be working towards no longer accepting cash and cheque payments, making the school a cash-free environment. Parents who need to continue making payments by cash may do so using the PayPoint network at local convenience stores. Our nearest one is Whitmore Food Centre, 20-24 Whitmore Road. Please notify the Office if you wish to use the PayPoint facility. A plastic card will be issued to you to make cash payments for school meals at local PayPoint stores. We hope you will support us in achieving our goal to become a cashless school. Your support in using ParentPay will help the school enormously, thank you.
