What have the children been interested in?

The children have been busy engaging in lots of open ended creative endeavours with block building and transient art. We have been getting inspiration from the

range of colours and textures found in leaves, conkers, pine cones and other Autumn finds in the garden. This has given the children lots of opportunities to expand their vocabulary, talk about why and how the seasons change, notice and talk

about details, differences and similarities in natural resources. We have also been learning lots of sorting skills and practical maths talking about counting, pattern making, shapes, arrangements and measurement. The children have been working well together discussing how to create beautiful pieces of art and confidently sharing their ideas and opinions throughout the creative process.





Home Learning

You could go on a treasure hunt at the park or around the house to collect conkers, leaves or even bottle tops and buttons to make your own transient art home. You could lay out paper or material and talk to your child about what they are making. Remember to let them lead and give them plenty of time to talk and share their ideas!
