What we have been learning?

During the last 2 weeks we have provided children with opportunities to explore, investigate and experiment. They have been involved in growing cress, gardening, looking at snails and ants and have investigated what happens when you mix cornflour and water. We have focused on supporting the children's language development as well as broadening their vocabulary by using new words such as texture, smooth, mucus, slime and the names of plants.



Maybe you could grow your own cress at home, it's really easy and grows quickly!
