#### Attendance at Comet

At Comet we believe it is really important for children to attend every day and that they are on time. This allows your child to start the beginning of their session with their friends and gives them positive life skills on the importance of being on time.

Our session times in Sun and Star Room (3 and 4 year olds) are:-

Morning session 9 - 11.30am
Afternoon session 12.45 - 3.15pm
30 hours provision 9am - 3pm
Full day for part time 9am - 3.15pm

The register is completed every day. If you bring your child later than 9.20am or 1pm you will need to see Katie, Kelly or Jenny in the office and your child will be marked in late. If you need to collect your child early we would ask that you do so by 11am or 2.45pm or 3pm for Moon Room, so children are not disturbed in their story time. It is also really important that your child is collected on time.

Our session times in Moon Room (2 year olds) are:-

Morning session 8.30 - 11.30am (if you arrive after 8.45am, you will be

asked to wait outside until 9am to reduce disruption)

Afternoon session 12.30 - 3.30pm

#### **Early Years Pupil Premium and Free School Meals**

If you are in receipt of certain benefits such as income support and jobseeker's allowance and think your child is entitled to free school meals please go to the Hackney Learning Trust website and register to get your child a free school meal. Without confirmation of free school meals you will be charged the daily rate of £2.00. A daily menu is displayed outside Sun Room.

If you are entitled to free school meals the school automatically gets Early Years Pupil Premium funding. This allows us to take children on trips, offer Forest School and gardening activities. We really do rely on this extra funding to make sure our children get lots of different opportunities to extend their learning.

We are giving away a FREE Comet t-shirt to all children who are entitled to free schools meals as a thank you for registering.

#### What have the children been interested in so far?

The children have been very interested in exploring the changes in the season. Some children visited Shoreditch Park to collect leaves and conkers for our display. They have also harvested and eaten tomatoes that have grown in our nursery garden.

We have noticed that many of the children have shown a real 'can do' attitude by persevering when they have tried out new activities and experiences, even when they found it difficult.

Moon room have visited Snake Park, they enjoyed playing in the sandpit and testing out their climbing skills.

#### Home Learning

We have lots of information and ideas for home learning for parents in the hall. Please take anything you think you and your child would like to do at home.



We also provide a book borrowing service. Children will have been provided with a school book bag and they will choose a book to bring home every Wednesday. Please share this book with you child and also keep it safe and cared for. We ask that you return the book bag the following Tuesday ready

for a new book.

We have some Breakfast and Tea Club spaces available for children in Sun or Star Room. If you would like to know more please see the office.

#### Please name your child's clothes

Please can you name your child's clothes especially the Comet sweatshirts. If you have lost any clothes please see the lost property box in the hall.

Don't forget to provide your child with a spare set of clothes to keep at nursery. There is a named bag on their peg. The bag must be kept at school.

Please also make sure your child has good shoes for running and climbing and a coat now it's getting colder.


## Macmillan Coffee Morning/Afternoon - Thursday 27th September
