What we've been learning

The children have been noticing the change in weather as we settle into winter. This has been a really great opportunity to support the children in becoming more independent with keeping warm. So far we have tackled putting coats, hats, scarves and gloves on with growing independence – they are doing really well with this! We have also been exploring how to keep our bodies warm when outside. This has allowed the opportunity for lots of active play, making sure we keep moving and go inside when we feel like we need to heat up.

How you can help at home:

- Make sure all your children's clothing is labelled and draw their attention to their name in their clothes. This will help their independence even further.
- Talk to your child about seasonal changes they might see on the way to school such as, trees with no leaves, how they see their breath on very cold days, maybe even a flurry of snow or an icy puddle!
